Dear Parent/ Carers and Students,

This year's public examinations open with GCSE Psychology on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> May and conclude with A-level Maths on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> June. The full summer timetable is available on the [Exams Information](#) page of our school website.

As we approach the Easter break, we would like to emphasise the importance of purposeful and well-structured revision in the leadup to these examinations. The holiday period provides an excellent opportunity for students to consolidate their learning, refine their exam techniques, and build confidence as they prepare for the weeks ahead.

Effective revision requires thoughtful planning. We encourage students to create a realistic revision timetable that includes all subjects, while also allowing time for breaks and rest to sustain motivation. This balanced approach helps to maintain focus and reduces the likelihood of last minute stress.

Engaging with past examination papers remains one of the most effective ways to develop familiarity with question styles and timing. This approach not only strengthens confidence but also helps identify any areas needing further attention. Students may also find it beneficial to revise collaboratively with friends or family members, as explaining concepts aloud can deepen understanding. To support this, we run a weekly *Past Paper Club* for Year 11 and Year 13 students on Thursdays after school in the Sixth Form Study Hub. Students who cannot attend may collect past paper packs to take home.

Subject teachers have also updated their Revision Schedules, which can be found on Firefly and the school website. These schedules outline key topics, signpost useful resources, and include a RAG rating system to help students identify priorities:

1. **Red:** knowledge not secure
2. **Amber:** knowledge secure in-part
3. **Green:** knowledge is secure

In addition, several subjects will be offering in school, face to face revision sessions over the Easter break. Details of these sessions are listed below. Students attending should arrive shortly before the scheduled start time and sign in at Reception, where they will be met by the relevant teacher. Those attending both morning and afternoon sessions are encouraged to bring a packed lunch, though the lunch break is long enough to purchase food offsite if preferred. School uniform and Sixth Form dress code are not required on these days.
