Students who achieve 100% attendance and receive no late marks or C points next week will be entered into a prize draw to win one of a number of prizes.

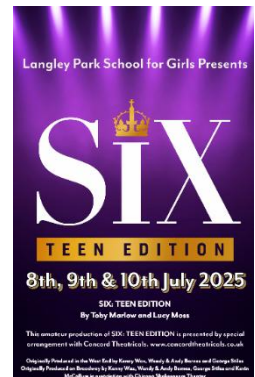
