Dear Families,

I am pleased to inform you that we will be taking students to see a performance of Macbeth in the Autumn term of Year 11. This will be a valuable opportunity for students to experience Shakespeare's work in a live theatre setting, supporting their learning and understanding of their set text for GCSE English Literature.

The performance will take place on Wednesday 4th November and is a matinée, starting at 1pm at Greenwich Theatre. We will be travelling from Eden Park Station at approximately 11am and changing at Lewisham Station to the Cutty Sark Station which is a short walking distance to the theatre. The performance's running time is still to be confirmed and our return time will be communicated in due course.

Outside food and drink cannot be consumed in the theatre so students must eat a packed lunch whilst travelling. If your child is in receipt of free school meals, they can collect a packed lunch from the canteen at the start of the day. If students opt to bring valuables such as mobile phones, they do so at their own risk. There will not be many opportunities for students to spend money so we recommend they bring no more than £10. All students are expected to be in normal school uniform for the day.

This is an optional trip and we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £15.20 per student, payable via MCAS by 10th April, to secure your child's place on the trip. Students in receipt of Pupil Premium will be funded. If we do not receive enough voluntary contributions, the trip cannot go ahead so your co-operation in responding promptly is appreciated. As always, if parents/carers feel they can make a contribution on behalf of another student as well as their own, this is very much appreciated. There is a small fund available to help students in need, please see our [website](#) for more information (scroll down the page and click on "Other Information").

We have applied for free travel from TfL, however, students should bring a topped up travel card in the event they wish to disembark from a different station on the Eden Park Line on the return journey. If you wish your child to get off at an alternative station, please indicate this on the consent form which will be sent to you during the Summer term via our trip system, Evolve. If we do not receive consent for this trip then your child will not be able to attend.

Please note that any student may be removed from the trip should their behaviour be a cause for concern in school.
