Re: Year 7 & Year 8 Assessment Weeks: 1st - 12th December

We are writing to inform you about the upcoming Key Stage 3 (KS3) Assessment Weeks, scheduled to take place between **Monday 1st December and Friday 12th December**. These assessments will occur during normal lesson times and are designed to provide valuable insights into your child's progress across their subjects.

Today, Year 7 and 8 students took part in a Revision Tips and Strategies workshop. In this session, they were provided with a blank revision timetable to populate with the topics as outlined below. Students were asked to block out time for clubs and activities to ensure a healthy balance between study and recreation.

The workshop was structured to also consider:

Revision methods

- Finding a method that works well for your child, such as flash cards, mind maps, peer teaching etc.

Healthy habits

- Sleeping, eating, and screentime habits were looked at, along with their advantages and disadvantages.

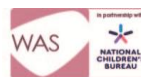
